## NACCTFO TREASURER:

Section 6. The treasurer shall serve as chairperson of the Budget Committee, shall keep an accurate roll of all county collectors, treasurers and finance officers, shall see that dues notices are issued annually to all members of every classification, with the exception of Honorary and Life members, in accordance with Articles III and IV, shall deposit all funds with a reliable bank, and shall promptly pay those claims which have been authorized by the current year budget. The position of treasurer shall be elected in alternate years from the election of the position of secretary and shall typically be for a two-year term. It shall be the treasurer's responsibility to forward all current NACCTFO funds and financials to his/her elected NACCTFO successor. The treasurer shall regularly make a detailed financial report of the affairs and conditions of NACCTFO to the Executive Committee each month, to the membership at each business meeting of NACCTFO and to the president upon request. The report shall include actual expenses and revenues to the budget. Further, the treasurer shall timely make available all books and records to the Executive Committee and Audit Committee and shall be reimbursed for budgeted expenses incurred.
